9 to 19 March 2026

The seventieth session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW70) will take place at United Nations Headquarters in New York from 9 to 19 March 2026.

This year's CSW priority theme focuses on ensuring and strengthening access to justice for all women and girls, including by promoting inclusive and equitable legal systems, eliminating discriminatory laws, policies and practices, and addressing structural barriers. The session will examine persistent gaps in women's access to justice and explore pathways to strengthen accountability, institutional reform and legal protections in line with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

Access to justice cannot be separated from the structural inequalities that shape women's lives – including the unequal distribution of unpaid and paid care work. Care responsibilities often create time poverty, limit economic autonomy and restrict women's ability to seek legal redress. CSW70 therefore presents a critical opportunity to connect justice reform with care systems transformation and to position care as a central pillar of gender equality and human rights.

Alliance members are engaging in the context of CSW70 through coordinated advocacy, events and communications initiatives designed to ensure that care is recognized as a right, a public good and a shared social responsibility. These collective efforts are reflected in the Care Agenda of the Global Alliance for Care at CSW70.

For the purposes of this compilation, only events with a primary focus on care – including those that explicitly reference care in the title – have been included in the Care Agenda. While Alliance members are organizing and participating in additional events related to broader gender equality, justice and development themes, this compilation reflects a deliberate focus on initiatives where care is the central theme.
